Bimol Singh is now 32 years of age. He is a daily wage earner. He has two kids. He went to a local govt. school. He knows Manipuri, mother tongue. He can't read an English text. He wish if they were taught English properly in school, he could live a better life.

1.6 lac children enrolled in govt. schools in Manipur, all from economically most backward families. How many of them will fall in the cycle of Bimol's fate? Number is pretty high, if not intervene !

Only 50.1% of Grade III, V, VIII can read text of Grade II in India.




